Welcome - Croeso to Year 1

My name is Mrs Carr and I am your child's teacher for the coming year, with Mrs Watt as the Year 1 LSA. I hope that the following will help you understand our routines and expectations.

Year 1

Our classroom is a lively, interactive space, where your child will learn to develop their independent skills as well as continue to be an integral part of the Y Bont Faen family.

Our classroom is located in the Foundation Phase department, and is a shared area with the Year 2 class. We also have an outdoor learning area that leads off from our classroom

The children come into school at 8.55am. If you are late, please go straight to the main office at the front of the school and report to Mrs Cross. Please don't send your child around to our yard on their own, as the doors could be closed

If you are going to be late picking up your child at the end of the day, please call the office, so that we can reassure your child that you are on your way.

SPELLINGS

In Year 1, your child will have a weekly spelling test, which will take place on their reading day. The spelling list that your child will need to practise and learn will be sent home on their reading day and then they will be tested following their next reading session. The tests will focus on specific letter patterns. The children will then bring home their test, and their new set of words ready for the following week. When children share their tests with you, it's important to praise them for the parts they got right and reinforce the parts of the word that they got wrong. Remember to be positive, learning to spell the patterns of the English language can be tricky!
