<p><b>Key word recognition games</b> Word cards provided Cut up the cards and practise reading them by sight. Turn them over, pick a card. If you can read it confidently keep it. Try and beat your score each day Sort and read words beginning with the same letter. Sort and read 1 letter words, 2 letter words 3 etc. Spot the words in reading books Practise writing the words. Can you find words to rhyme with them? Play I spy - Look at the cards and spy words beginning with a certain letter. Use the words in a sentence. Look for tricky parts in any of the words e.g. was The tricky part is "a"</p>	<p><b>Counting</b> Use the number line and 100 square provided to count and recognise numbers Name the number 1 more than ... 1 less than ... Count in 10s Count backwards from 10 Count from different starting numbers</p> <p><b>Number</b> Explore different ways to make 10 e.g. 5+5, 9+1 Add 2 groups of objects together to find a total Move on to adding 2 numbers together Roll 2 dice add the values</p>
<p><b>Writing</b> Make and write a card for somebody. Write a shopping list List of ingredients needed for a recipe Write an invitation for a toys tea party Read a story, draw a picture about the story and write a sentence about it. Draw characters from a story and write speech or thought bubbles. Create a MISSING or WANTED poster for a character from a story. Create groups of rhyming words Practise spelling 3 and 4 letter words, and key words - write them in rainbow colours.</p>	<p><b>Money</b> Play with money Recognise the coins 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p and 20p Set up a play shop, make price labels, find the correct coins to buy things Make totals with 1p coins first, moving on to different coins</p> <p><b>Shape</b> Recognise and name 2d and 3d shapes Be a Shape Detective -go on a shape hunt around the house or garden Symmetrical patterns (visit topmarks website for symmetry game</p>
<p><b>Reading</b> Share a range of stories and talk about the events and characters. Predict the ending to stories Look at some non-fiction books and discuss features such as, index, headings and sub-headings, photographs etc. Discuss how they differ from story books.</p>	<p><b>Topic</b> Listen to a piece of music, think of words to describe it fast/slow, loud/quiet lively/calm</p> <p>Create a fairy tale castle- it could be a painting, 3d junk model, or collage</p> <p>Look for signs of Spring - draw and label them</p>
<p><b>Oracy</b> Understand what a question is. Collect a list of questioning words to help your child create different questions.
