<p><u>Handwriting</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can you write your full name using rainbow writing? Remember to start from the top and write left to right.... Can you write 5 words with the 'er' blend How many words can you find in the word rainforest? Can you watch the alphabet video on HWB http://resources.hwb.wales.gov.uk/VTC/ngfl/ngfl-flash/alphabets-eng/alphabets.htm then in your book write each letter in lower case. Challenge - can you write the matching capital letter? <p><u>Writing</u></p> <p>Have a look at an online travel blog (lonely planet is a good one) - then in your book, can you write an advert for a holiday in Brazil? Why should people visit it? You could also draw a picture of some of the fabulous things to see and do there...</p> <p>Have a look at National Geographic Kids website - in the search button, type in 'Brazil' then have a read through the 'Brazil Facts, discover this super cool country' with a grown up, then answer as many of these questions as you can, writing the answers in your book:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What language do they speak? What is the name of the rainforest? How many times has Brazil won the FIFA World cup? What is the flat, swampy area called?
