Knowledge and Understanding of the World

- Experiment time! Water on Earth is recycled over and over again, it's always moving. It is this recycling process that we call the water cycle. Can you make your own? You will need: - a plastic bowl, cling film, a mug, string and water. On a sunny day, place the mug at the bottom of a bowl and add water around the mug so that it is about a finger space from the top of the mug. If you can, draw a mark on the side of the bowl where the water level is. Cover the bowl tightly in cling film and fasten in place with string. Watch what happens! You should find that there are drops of water on the cling film and that the water level has gone down in the bowl!
