<p><b><u>What is a crustacean?</u></b></p> <p>Can you use a search engine to find out about crustaceans? Use the address bar to search for the Tasmanian giant crab, the Japanese spider crab, the mantis shrimp and the white-clawed crawfish. View and read web pages to find out about what they eat, what they look like and how they have adapted to their habitat. You can present your findings anyway you like, a poster, a Powerpoint, a list - be as creative as you can!</p>	<p><b><u>What's the word?</u></b></p> <p>Can you create a wordsearch using the newly learned crustacean words? You can add other seaside words if you like. If you are going to do this by hand - make a grid (a bit like the 100 square) - fill in your words (across, down, backwards or even diagonal!) then add random letters around them! Write the words they need to find underneath the grid. Then, challenge someone in your family to find the words - have fun!</p>
