| <p><u>DCF - JIT?</u> Can you practice your coding skills on J2code? You will need to log on to your HWB account, then go onto J2Easy, then click on the j2code page. Then look for the turtle character - JIT coding platform for KS1. Use your mouse or keys to move your chosen character around - think about where you would like to navigate to before you start. Also think about whether you are moving your character 'forward' 'left' 'right' or 'backward'.
