Matters discussed	Action
1. Welcome to the PTA meeting was given by Sarah King (SK) who thanked all for attending and apologies were noted.	
Key actions:	
1. Ink Jet Recycling update- ST confirmed that bin arrived this week. ST to set up.	ST to co-ordinate advertising to parents
2. Car wash Fundraiser - JA confirmed that Fire station were supportive of the idea but are currently unable to assist with a car wash due to Covid 19 restrictions. Agreed to put this suggestion on hold until restrictions allow.	
Items of Business	
1. The last financial position statement prepared showed £8,107.00 held in the main account (of which £3000.00 was running track ring fenced). Moneys in have included £32.21 art fundraiser and £20.50 HRT reimbursement for Easter Prizes. Moneys out have included £250.00 for the yoga / mindfulness scheme.	
2. SK advised that Landscapes4learning have encountered delays and may not be able to deliver to the promised mid-June deadline. She will follow this up and try and secure original dates with emphasis that year 6 are hoping to use it for their Shakespeare production.	
JA advised that she has a parent with machinery able to scrape the area for preparation if that would help speed installation process. SK will chase a start date. JA advised that with regards to funding the invoice has	SK



gone to the bank to secure the 9k grant and sufficient funds are in the school account to pay the invoice while waiting for the grant payment.	
3. AB has secured a £40.00 donation to use for smarties purchase from Tesco and Waitrose may be able to provide some but a significant quantity. The rest will be purchased along with an alternative treat for any children with allergies. Estimated costs will be £50.00. AB will co-ordinate purchases. ST&AB have worked on a flyer to go with the smarties tubes explaining what is required for the challenge ready to be distributed on the last day of term. JA confirmed that a class surprise was acceptable as a reward for the class that returns the most tubes. The surprise would be Goldentime/ film afternoon or non-uniform for the class bubble or similar.	
4. Duck Race date is still to be confirmed but likely to be end of July to tie in with a year 6 enterprise week. Year 6 will co ordinate sales again, PTA to provide prizes likely to be a £50.00 voucher for The Yard as first prize funded by HRT as part of their sponsorship package, SK will approach Fablas and ST will co-ordinate a lollies for the class prize.	
5. Discussion over Crazy hair day fundraiser and when to hold it and how many activities to hold over the next term so as not to put too much pressure on families. Decided to try and space activities out and hold Crazy Hair as a separate event on Friday 2 July.	
6. Other fundraising options - to be reviewed at next meeting depending on success of JustGiving fundraising. ST outlined that a JustGiving crowd funding page has been set up with a target of £3000.00 specifically for the outdoor classroom.
