Year 1 enjoyed a visit to Swansea Waterfront Museum, where they met the Pirate Barti Ddu. He taught the children all about the life of a pirate and they looked at how he used different props to help tell a story. Year 2 enjoyed their trip to Cardiff Museum where they learnt about some different types of art and did some art of their own in the gallery. They couldn't leave without a quick visit to the dinosaurs and to see the mammoth! Year 3 fantastic had a fantastic time at their PBuzz celebration on Tuesday: they all joined in and appreciated the wonderful music we got to listen to.

This week Nursery have enjoyed matching animals to their babies and learning some new baby animal names. Reception have learnt about the Easter story, beginning with role-playing key events, followed by ordering pictures, and then writing a couple of sentences to show what they had learned.

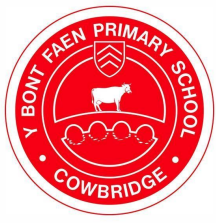
Year 1 wrote invitations to Year 4 to share their story of The Enormous Leek with them and to see which version they like best! Year 2 have been investigating which material would be the best to make a nest for Plop (the owl who is afraid of the dark!). They decided that they needed something that let a lot of light through to make his nest as light as possible. Year 3 have been learning all about fractions. They started using concrete materials and counting out cubes to find the denominator, then identifying which fraction of the cubes were a certain colour and expressing this as the numerator to make their fraction.

Year 4 have been learning about symmetry through using the outdoors, and reflecting shapes across vertical and horizontal lines of symmetry. They also had fun creating their own symmetrical shapes using pasta! Year 5 explored the concept of probability. They took part in a bean bag toss activity, where the children predicted which zone the bean bag would land in using the terms of probability. Year 6 have been looking at the Welsh artist Bethan Ash. The children chose a painting that interested them and used frames to try to recreate certain parts of her works.
